BETHANY TOUR

9am to 6pm

The "Betania Circuit" is a popular tour in Lençóis Maranhenses, departing from Santo Amaro, which explores the region's dunes and lagoons, including the famous Betânia Lagoon. The full-day tour includes stops for swimming in lagoons, lunch in Betânia (with an optional boat ride), and sunset viewing from a dune.





AMENDED LAGOONS

1:30 pm to 7:00 pm

During the 45-minute 4x4 drive, you'll be treated to stunning landscapes and crystal-clear lagoons. Afterwards, there's a 30- to 40-minute hike to Lagoa das Emendadas, guided by a professional who knows every corner of this paradise, brimming with charm and natural beauty.



● SWALLOWS & SEAGULLS

9am to 12pm

Lagoa da Andorinha and Lagoa da Gaivota are the most popular in Santo Amaro. They are located very close to the city, and their easy access makes them among the most visited. The great advantage, especially for those who can't or don't want to take long walks, is that 4x4 vehicles can reach practically the edge of the lagoons.





GREEN TIP

9am to 6pm

Maioba Lagoon will be your first stop for a nice swim in crystal-clear waters, to relax, and disconnect from everything. Chairs and umbrellas are provided during the tour. Around 11:30 am, you'll continue your adventure toward Ponta Verde Village, known as a fishing village inhabited by people who survive through artisanal fishing. These people are sometimes called "caiçaras." Descending the dunes, the trail begins through the vegetation and, on the right, passes Lake Guapiriba, until you reach the Ponto de Apoio (restaurant) Recanto Preguiça, where the menu includes free-range chicken and seafood. After lunch, you can relax in the hammock provided by the restaurant and gaze out over the lake, or take a dip in the water.

At 3:30 pm, we continue the tour, stopping along the way to sample local fruits. Next, we'll visit the main lagoon, Lagoa Do Reflexo. A breathtaking setting, unique landscapes in the world.

The tour lasts a full day and ends at Criuli (the name given by the locals), where the sun sets, reflecting on the waters of Lagoa da Jangada.





TRAVOSA

9am to 6pm

The Travosa Tour offers an unforgettable journey through deserted and paradisiacal landscapes along the Park's West Coast, revealing the hidden beauty of the Maranhão coast. Travosa, a charming village, is the perfect destination for those looking to explore untouched nature and relax in a peaceful and enchanting setting.

This tour is ideal for those who want to experience the remote beauty of the region and enjoy the peace of a deserted beach, far from the tourist crowds, with the advantage of exploring one of the most unique and natural places in Maranhão.



LAGOON OF AMERICA

9am to 12pm or 3pm to 6pm



Lagoa América is a great option for those looking to escape the routine of 4x4 travel. The lagoon, located on the outskirts of Santo Amaro, is accessible by boat or speedboat, passing through a large flooded area on the outskirts of the city. The speedboat ride is quick, taking only 25 minutes. For those traveling by boat, the journey is a little slower, taking an hour to reach the dune field.

The route is beautiful, but the best part is reaching the lagoons, where there are almost no people.



RANCHARIA

9am to 6pm



The journey is made in 4x4 vehicles and takes a maximum of 35 minutes through the dune fields. Arriving in Rancharia, the car stops near the mountain range, and you'll have a short walk over it. To reach the main destination, you can take a boat, which takes an average of 10 minutes, or walk through a flooded area to the lagoon, which takes about 15 minutes. Finally, all this is rewarded with a spectacular view of Bicudo Gordo Lagoon. The immensity of the lagoon and sand dunes—forming the famous sheets—looks like a scene from a science fiction film. Not to mention the privilege of a 360-degree view of the Lençóis Maranhenses. Water so crystal clear you won't want to leave.

The tour lasts a full day, with a break for lunch in a nearby village. Finally, you'll stop at other lagoons for a nice goodbye swim, before returning to the highest point to watch the sunset.



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
